# Patient Protection and Affordable Health Care Act

- Mandated funds for SBHCs
  - \$200 million for capital outlay and equipment (\$50 million/year for the next 4 years)
- Mandated funds for Community Health Centers
  - \$11 **Billion**
  - For capital outlay and operations
  - Opportunity to connect with your CHC

# SBHC Funds

- For capital improvement (bricks and mortar) and equipment
- NOT for operational expenses
- RFP - competitive; release expected in Summer 2010
- Quick turn around required for this year's funds

# Eligibility to Apply

- SBHCs
- SBHC sponsoring facilities/entities
  - Hospitals
  - Public health departments (SBHC sponsor)
  - Community Health Centers
  - Non-profits (SBHC sponsor)
  - Schools or school systems
  - Tribes or tribal organizations
  - University

# Eligibility to Apply

- SBHCs that serve areas with high Medicaid eligibility
- Regulations (to be out soon) will provide more clarity

# Use of Funds

- Construct new SBHCs
- Expand or renovate existing SBHCs
- Equipment
  - Technology
  - Medical
  - Dental
  - Furniture

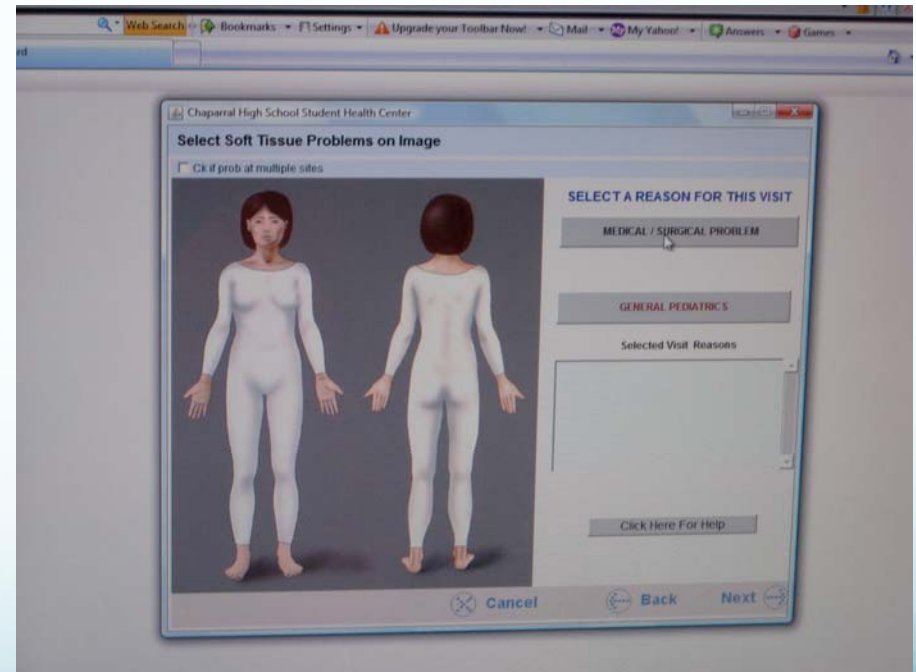


# State of the Art Medical Equipment

- Electronic medical records



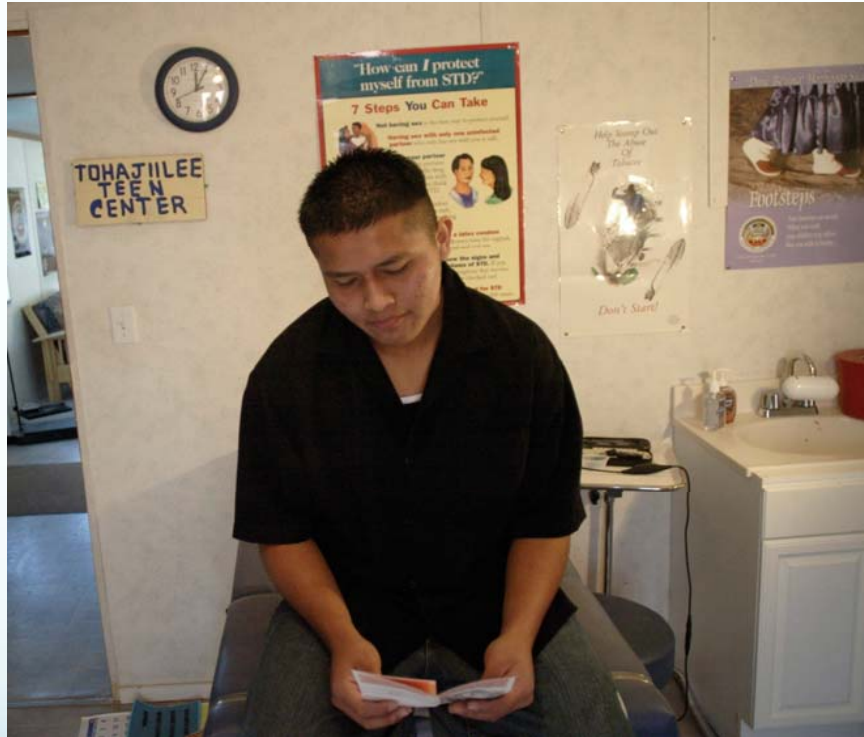
# Service Data

16,121 clients served by	DOH's 59 SBHCs
44,806 visits at	DOH's 59 SBHCs
47 SBHCs	Approved to bill Medicaid

Reason for Visit/Diagnosis	
Primary Care Office Visits	42%
Behavioral Health Office Visits	33%
EPSDT/Well child	7%
Immunization	6%
Screening/Tests	5%
Family Planning	3%
